For naming your output PDF file, please use the presenting authors' initials and complete family name, with no space, all in lowercase. Add a hyphen and number starting from 1 to identify multiple abstracts from the same author, keeping the .pdf extension. If this was Professor Bauthor's second abstract, the filename would be: bbauthor-2.pdf.
